

Fall 2022 Start Strong Assessments

- Serves as a formative assessment.
- Measures a subset of priority prior -year academic standards and indicates the level of support a students needs to engage in grade-level content.



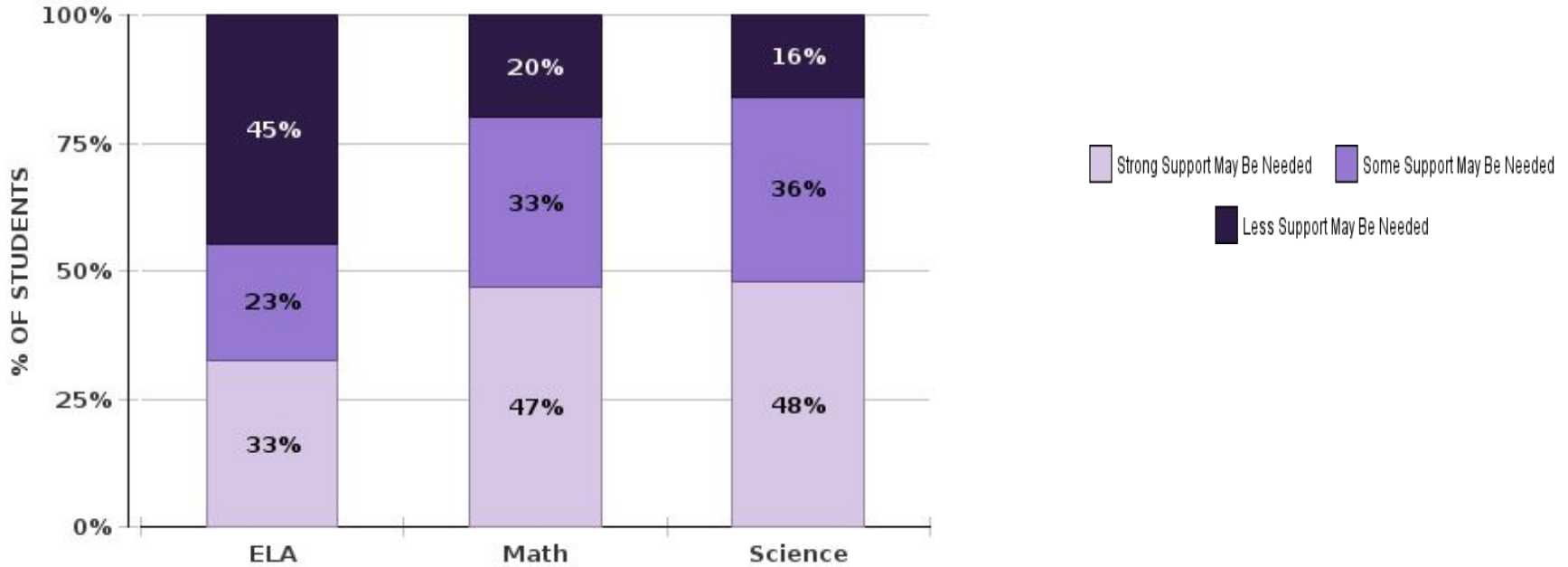
The purpose of an analysis of this data is to understand the level of support that students require for **CURRENT** grade level support.

TAKEAWAYS

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS (ELA)

- Students performance indicated that we need to closely monitor a subset of students that may require more support to engage in grade-level content, but overall students in Hawthorne require less support in this subject area.
- Data from this assessment was used to further categorize students in Tier 2 and Tier 3 Supports K-12.

MATHEMATICS

- Students performance indicated that we need to closely monitor a larger cohort of students that may require more support to engage in grade-level content.
- Data from this assessment was used to further categorize students in Tier 2 and Tier 3 Supports K-12.
- Instructional strategies have been introduced in the K-12 classroom to enhance students acquisition of mathematical knowledge.
