Special Education Students with significant challenges participated in alternate assessments for English Language Arts, Math, and Science (DLM).

15 students took the test, so data is best used on an individual basis. No subgroup had more than 10 students (see below) - so reporting data may be identifiable.

- <u>Grades 3</u>: 6 students <u>Grade 4</u>: 4 students <u>Grade 5</u>: 3 students
- <u>Grades 6 and 7</u>: 1 students <u>Grade 8</u>: 3 student
- <u>Grade 11</u>: 1 students

The special services department is working with teachers to review students' individual score reports and adjust classroom support systems as needed.
