If you believe that your child's quarantine or isolation timeframe qualifies to be adjusted, your school nurse will be able to assist you.

Day 0 is the day of the test May return to school on day 6, <u>IF</u> symptoms subside and/or 24 hours fever free without fever-reducing medicine LMS and HHS students on days 6-10 will be exempted from activities that would normally allow for no mask to be worn (i.e., athletic practice/competition, chorus/band. Again, this restriction is only for days 6-10.
Close Contact OR Family member awaiting test OR Family member positive (household contact)	Fully Vaccinated Previously Positive (within the past 90 days with PCR or NAAT)	No quarantine is required. If symptoms develop, stay home and contact your school nurse
Family member awaiting test	Unvaccinated Not Fully Vaccinated	Stay home until test results are received. If individual receives positive test results than follow household contact guidance

Travel Guidance

Travel - Unvaccinated **Both International & Domestic	 Domestic and international travelers who are not fully vaccinated should Get tested with a PCR or NAAT test 3-5 days after travel AND return with a negative test
Travel - Vaccinated **International Travel Only	Stay home AND Get tested with a PCR or NAAT test 3-5 days after travel. Students / staff may return to school upon receipt of a negative test.
