EXPOSURE	STATUS	OUTCOME
<b>COVID-19 Positive Asymptomatic</b>	Fully Vaccinated Previously Positive Unvaccinated Not Fully Vaccinated Not previously Positive	Isolate for 5 full days. Day 0 is the day of the test. May return to school on day 6, but are required to wear a mask from Days 6-10.  If symptoms develop within one week of the positive test, the 5-day isolation period starts over with day 0 being the first day of symptoms
<b>COVID-19 Positive Symptomatic</b>	Fully Vaccinated Previously Positive Unvaccinated Not Fully Vaccinated Not previously Positive	Isolate for 5 full days. Day 0 is the day of the test  May return to school on day 6, <b>IF</b> symptoms subside and/or 24 hours fever free without fever-reducing medicine
<b>Close Contact</b>  <b>Or</b>  <b>Household Contact</b>	Unvaccinated Not Fully Vaccinated Not previously Positive Previously Positive greater than 90 days	Quarantine for 5 days with a return to school/work on day 6 if symptom free.  Day 0 is the last day of contact or last day of exposure
<b>Experiencing COVID-19 symptoms but not identified as a close contact</b>	Fully Vaccinated Previously Positive Unvaccinated Not Fully Vaccinated Not previously Positive	Get tested and remain home until test results are received.  <b>Untested</b> requires you to stay home for 5 days with day 0 being the first day of symptoms - symptoms must be subsiding for you to return to work/school  <b>OR</b>  Alternate diagnosis from a physician (eg. strep throat, flu, RSV). Contact the school nurse for illness related exclusion
<b>NEW TRAVEL</b>  <b>International Travel ONLY</b>	ALL TRAVELERS	Show proof of a negative COVID-19 test used to return to the United States. Monitor symptoms for 3-5 days - no quarantine unless symptoms arise.
